Harvesting Services

Squires Timber Company has long been considered a pioneer in many of today's harvesting procedures. Equipment design and advances allow us to harvest timber without



damaging the environment. Smaller crews with specialized equipment are used for plantation thinning and residential/development harvest in urban areas. Larger crews are used in whole tract utilization cuts, while crews with high flotation equipment are used in hardwood shovel applications.
